# ENGLISCH Auffrischung A2 – Refresher Consolidation B1

Wenn Sie Englisch in der Schule hatten, also über Kenntnisse verfügen und diese auffrischen und erweitern möchten, machen Sie diesen Test. Er dient dazu, Sie bei der Wahl des passenden Kurses zu unterstützen.

Es handelt sich überwiegend um einen sogenannten Multiple Choice Test, d. h. es sind für jede Frage mehrere Antwortmöglichkeiten vorgegeben, von denen Sie die richtige ankreuzen.
